SOLDIERS	Roman soldiers assigned to Iconium (from Chorus)
IONE	A Greek woman, 30-35, married to Demetrius, sensitive and strong in the faith.
MARTHA	A Jewish woman, 30-35, married to Reuben. Ione’s close friend, caught between race and friendship.
HELEN	A Greek woman.
LEAH	A Jewish woman, married to a wealthy landowner.
SAMUEL	Leah’s son, 18-24, eager to sample the world.
REUBEN	A prominent Jew in the Iconium church, 40, married to Martha, self-concerned, ambitious.
DEMETRIUS	A Greek man, 35-40, married to Ione, friend to Reuben, people-pleaser, insecure.
HANNAH	A Jewish widow in her 40’s, lonely, out to land a husband.
MATTHIAS	Jewish leader from the Jerusalem church, in his 50’s, part of the circumcision party.
JOSEPH	Jewish man in his 40’s, assistant to Matthias.
ELIZABETH	A young Jewish woman, 18-24.
CHORUS	Jewish and Gentile members of the Iconium church.
